

JOIN US AT THE 2023 SEGP AGM!



OTHER EVENTS



Standing as a non-target candidate is **vitaly important for our status and our credibility.**

It also **gives us a really good idea of where our support lies**, so we know where to focus in the future!

Standing as a non-target candidate is one of the most useful things you can do for us!

How much work is it?

Almost none at all! All it takes to stand as a non-target candidate for us is **10 minutes of paperwork and two signatures!**

Worried about getting elected? Don't be! In 2021, **we had no accidental wins.** Unfortunately, getting Greens elected takes a lot of hard work, **so it's very unlikely you will win!**

What is Mission Full Slate?

Mission Full Slate is our campaign to get non-target candidates to stand for in **as many wards as possible**, to make sure that everyone everywhere has a chance to vote Green!




